### **INTRODUCTION**

Internet access is available to students, teachers, and administrators of Community Unit District #205. We are happy to offer these services and believe it offers vast, diverse, and unique resources to both students and teachers. Our goal is to promote educational excellence for students of the district by enhancing our resources and communication.

### **ACCESS AND USE IN THE CLASSROOM**

Internet access is used in a limited capacity at the Elementary school. Teachers, the librarian and/or the technology coordinator will always preview any sites that may be used with the students in the classroom. These sites will be delivered to the students in the following two ways:

- A computer using a TV as a monitor will access the site for the entire class to view. This could include simulations, discussions, videos, etc.
- The teacher and/or technology coordinator will create a link page where students will click on a link and go only to the site on the web. This would include STI Assessment, skill and drill games, informational pages, etc.

Students will not be allowed to have unsupervised access at any time. The primary use will be to bring information to the student in a different way. The Internet offers many resources as a teaching tool for our district including sites that accompany some of the textbooks. Students may be working individually, in small groups or as a class at the discretion of the teacher.

Students will be taught responsible use of this tool. They will need to stay on task as with any other kind of work given to them. If they do something other than what they are instructed, the privilege will be taken away. They will be given an alternate form of the same work if necessary.
