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## **News from the Superintendent, Dr. Sirgany:**

### **Teacher In-service**

Our teachers were busy with an in-service this past Friday while the students were enjoying a 3 day weekend. The teachers learned of ways to provide appropriate instruction for all students, especially for those that find school more difficult. The teachers found the day to be very productive. This is one example of how we are continuing to work on our curriculum to ensure that it meets the needs of our students.

Our challenge is to teach all children at all levels. We are committed to that, and we will continue to look for ways to make all students more successful. As you can see we are continuing to make changes and to make good use of our in-service opportunities so that we can meet our commitment to children.

### **School Safety Report**

The local fire and police departments have been meeting with Warren CUSD #205 school members to discuss safety at school. We do this on a yearly basis in an effort to ensure we are doing everything possible to ensure the safety of our students and staff. With all of the issues that have arisen in rural schools during the past year, we decided as a group that it was time to become even more safety conscious than in prior years. Consequently it was decided to do a mock drill that involved an anhydrous spill. After the “spill” the fire and police departments, and the administration came together to discuss what happened and how we could improve upon our plan. The police saw this drill as a learning opportunity for themselves as well as for us. We will continue to run such type of drills in an effort to best ensure the safety of our students and staff.

### **Thanksgiving Service**

The Thanksgiving Service was well attended on Sunday. I am honored to be part of a service that brings many facets of the community together – the churches, school, American Legion, parents, community members, etc. are all active participants in the event. This is how I picture the first Thanksgiving Celebration as it took place nearly 400 years ago.

### **No Child Left Behind**

With No Child Left Behind raising the requirements every year, it is imperative that we as a staff continue to meet and discuss how we can continue to improve how we provide education for our students. Last year all of our students met the state and federal requirements. As a staff we are spending time trying to find ways to help all students do a better job in school. A number of teachers have gone to Response to Intervention Training in an effort to learn how to meet our goal of helping all students. I commend those teachers who have worked hard to learn new ways of teaching in the classroom. Other teachers have gone to Standard Aligned Curriculum meetings in order to gather ideas on what will work for different students and how we can ensure that what we teach is aligned to what the state says is most important. All of these teachers are returning to the school and sharing their ideas with each other. I appreciate how hard everyone is working to ensure the Warren School District is the best that it can be. We truly do not want to leave any students behind.

**BIGGER, FASTER, STRONGER PROGRAM**

All 7-12 students are participating in the Bigger, Faster, Stronger Program. The BFS Program is a Total Body Weightlifting Program which allows every student regardless of sport, age or gender to make great gains! This program consists of Core Lifts and Auxiliary Lifts. The basic Core lifts are Squat, Clean, Bench, and Dead Lift. The weight of each lift is recorded. At the end of each set, the combined weights for all weight lifted during that session is also recorded. The key to progress in any lifting program is technique. Proper body alignment is crucial to maintaining and building healthy tendons, ligaments, and bones. All students are instructed in safety first. Students begin with MAX tests as seen below. Next, students have to figure out seventy-five percent of their MAX to begin their lifting programs.

## ALL ABOUT CORE TRAINING

Strength Training students begin class with core training. Core strength training may be a relatively new, buzz term in the fitness industry but coaches and athletes have understood its value for many years. The core region consists of far more than just the abdominal muscles. In fact core strength training aims to target all the muscles groups that stabilize the spine and pelvis. It's these muscle groups that are critical for the transfer of energy from large to small body parts during many sporting activities. We primarily use Stability Balls, BOSU's, and Medicine Balls for core practice in our classes. The following are the super benefits of core training:

- Greater efficiency of movement
- Improved body control and balance
- Increased power output from both the core musculature and peripheral muscles such as the shoulders, arms and legs
- Reduced risk of injury (the core muscles act as shock absorbers for jumps and rebounds etc.)
- Improved balance and stability
- Improved athletic performance!
