News from the Superintendent, Dr. Sirgany:

Compliance Visit

The State was in the past week to do a Compliance Visit. We had not gone through such a process for 10 years. We were expected to prove we were complying with every rule and regulation the State has for school districts. Preparing for the visit was very time consuming for many staff members. I commend them on how hard they worked in order to show the State that we are doing everything that is expected of a school district. The auditors were very impressed with everything we showed them. This just goes to show what a hard working group of people we have working in our school district.

Flu and Coughs

I'm sure you've heard more than you ever wanted to hear about the H1N1 flu that is going around. Warren has been lucky so far with small numbers of students getting sick with the flu or at least being absent due to flu like symptoms as well as a bad cough. We are hoping that the Christmas break will give everyone a chance to recover. But if your child does get sick, remember to tell everyone in the family to wash their hands well. That is the top preventive measure. Remind your child to get plenty of rest and fluids, to stay home, and to take medicine to reduce the fever or the aches and pains.

Christmas Gifts and School

Many of our students will receive game boys, trading cards, etc. for Christmas. I would like to remind parents not to send such items to school. These items might be stolen or damaged. We would not want that to happen, thus I request that you please discuss with your children the importance of not bringing such items to school.

Boots, Hats, Gloves, and Snow Pants

Colder weather is now upon us. The playground is often cold or muddy at this time of year. The students need to be wearing their hats, gloves, snow pants, and boots to school. Please help us to remind them to get into the habit of wearing them to school.

Weather

I want to remind everyone to keep an eye on the weather as we move through the season. We do also notify the local radio stations and TV channels as soon as we make the decision to either cancel school or to let out early. This year we added Call-em-All to our list of ways to notify parents. At registration parents were given the opportunity to sign up to be called for days where there is no school, late starts, or early outs. This system has been working fairly well, and we will continue to improve upon it. If you aren't on our list, call 745-2641 and asked to be put on our list.

We will continue to keep the safety of the children in mind. It takes a minimum of one hour from the time we call school off to the time the buses arrive to take students home. We spend that time notifying the radio and TV stations, getting the drivers contacted, and double checking with any parents of students who might not be sure of where they are to go. It takes nearly 2 hours from the time we decide to call school off until the last student is home. Weather can change quickly in that time frame so if we error it will be on the side of safety.
